November & December

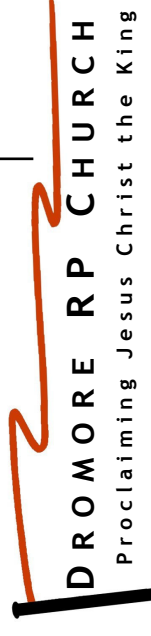

Introducing The Midweek
